The commission for FAST SA covered equipping 231 rooms and apartments with "hard" and upholstered furniture, and with lighting and necessary equipment, such as telephones and bathroom accessories. The company also undertook to arrange the public areas, including amongst others: the

reception area, restaurant, bar, café, conference rooms, SPA and changing rooms.

We looked for cutting-edge concepts which would harmoniously combine the modernity and comfort of the interior with the gorgeous view of the open sea.

The organization of such a large-scale operation was also quite a challenge: determining satisfying solutions when the Client's wishes confronted the construction process realities, translating them into the contractor's language and coordinating particular phases.
