The lobby walls are covered with veneered cladding in nut-brown color. Stand-alone upholstered furniture pieces are covered with fire-retardant fabrics.

The 4-star NARVIL Conference & Spa Hotel is another non-standard interior fit-up project implemented by FAST SA.

The modern shape of the building, harmoniously blending with the surrounding nature, required special space arrangement. The rooms – planned to be used for both leisure and business purposes – have been equipped with unique furniture designed by an architectural studio and fabricated by FAST SA.

Together with the other finishing

elements they create an atmosphere which fosters – in accordance with the philosophy of the hotel – spending time actively during both business and family trips.

"Apart from fabricating stylish furniture for 332 rooms, we also equipped the common areas: the reception area, the bars, the restaurant, the disco, the SPA, the swimming pool and the lobby. Thanks to the use of state-of-theart technologies we were able to fabricate profiled furniture, create

asymmetrical shapes and combine various materials – and it is here that our skills ideally "matched" the architect's design. The role of general contractor proved to be an interesting challenge for FAST, as it required in numerous instances going beyond the "furniture scope". It enabled us to use and extend our experience in the application of decorative plasters and in arranging space with the use of non-standard materials (for example exotic plants)," said Andrzej Haak, Commercial Director at FAST SA.
