“The project implemented for Orange was part of the rebranding carried out by Telekomunikacja Polska last year. Our company, chosen in the course of an official tender, convinced the Client with our long-standing experience, top-quality performance and an interesting, comprehensive bid,” says Andrzej Haak, Commercial Director of FAST SA.

The project – extremely demanding as regards logistics – included the fabrication and installation of new furniture at most of the Orange Showrooms in Poland. Due to the Client’s planned opening dates of particular Showrooms, many installation teams worked

simultaneously in several dozen cities and towns all over the country. Within several hours during the night they managed to install the furniture and equipment in accordance with the individual designs for particular Showrooms. “No delay of a single day, or even of several hours was acceptable, and for this reason the Project Manager had to be available 24 hours per day. Despite carefully prepared schedules, we had to remain vigilant and react flexibly to random events, such as the failure of a truck transporting furniture to a Showroom, etc. When that happens at night and action needs to be taken immediately, organizational skills and reliable people become particularly

important. We managed to overcome all obstacles, and that’s why the implementation of this project gave me so much satisfaction,” added Grzegorz Kropisz, the Project Manager.

For the fabrication of the equipment for the Orange Showrooms specially-designed, pressed, cut out and powder-coated metal elements, as well as original details made of stainless steel and plastic were used. Some furniture items were painted with opaque paints, whereas others were coated with glossy paints. Colorful, single-body furniture items decorate the Showrooms.
